Statement on Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)

After a detailed examination of the REACH regulation in our company, we inform you about the following:

The PEAK-System Technik GmbH belongs to the so-called “downstream users” and has no obligation for the registration of substances in accordance with REACH.

Our products are not substances that are defined in Article 3. They are products that release no substances if used correctly. According to Article 7, however, only substances can be registered as such and no products manufactured there from.

As a “downstream user“, we will comply with all requirements imposed on us by REACH.

According to the current state of knowledge, our products are free of SVHC substances according to REACH (1907/2006/EC). If we receive any deviating information from this, we take the obligation very seriously to pass on the information (Article 33 REACH) and inform our customers promptly and unsolicited.

All our suppliers are requested to deliver only REACH compliant products to us. If the conformity is not met, the suppliers are obliged to inform us about it.


Amendment of 21 December 2023
